2. A mounted photograph to include sheep. photo 7"x5" and mount 9"x7"
3. An article using any stitching technique.
4. An item of feltwork or felting.
5. A cushion in any medium.
6. An item of patchwork or quilting.
7. A toy in any medium.
8. A crocheted item.
9. A hand knitted garment.
10. Any other handicraft not listed in the schedule.
11. A poem on a countryside theme.

PRODUCE

12. Four sweet scones.
13. A lemon drizzle loaf.
14. A Victoria sandwich, three egg mixture with raspberry jam filling and dusted with Caster sugar.
15. A chocolate cake to include beetroot in the recipe.
16. A cheese and onion flan.
17. 3 decorated cup cakes.
18. A fruit pie on a plate, maximum size 7 inches.
19. 3 biscuits, any recipe
20. A decorated cake for a platinum jubilee, decoration only to be judged.

PRESERVES

Unless otherwise stated, all jars to have cellophane covers and rubber bands or twist tops in good condition.

21. A Jar of raspberry jam.
22. A Jar of strawberry jam.
23. A Jar of gooseberry jam.
24. A Jar of lemon curd, jar with cellophane and wax only.
25. A Jar of marmalade.
26. A Jar of sweet jelly.
27. A Jar of savoury jam.
28. A Jar of chutney. Jar to have a twist top.

FLOWERS

Measurements apply to height and width

29. An arrangement with one flower stem and foliage.
30. An arrangement entitled "Platinum Jubilee", not to exceed 24" x 24", accessories allowed
31. An arrangement from the hedgerow
32. A small container of mixed herbs, to include at least three varieties not to exceed 18" x 18"
33. An arrangement of supermarket flowers - not to exceed 24" x 24"
Price to be no more than £8 and receipt to be displayed.
34. An arrangement in an egg cup

RECYCLING

35. An item made from recycled card.
36. An item illustrating upcycling.
37. A item using recycled materials.
38. An item made out of crisp packets.

YCA SECTION RULES

- ◇ All entries must be made by the exhibitor, not shown at any previous Tockwith Show and have been completed within the last 18 months.
