1. Hand painted or drawn cartoon of a pig, any medium.
2. A mounted photograph to include a pig, photo 7"x5" and mount 9"x7"
3. An article using any stitching technique.
4. An item of feltwork or felting.
5. A cushion in any medium.
6. An item of patchwork or quilting.
7. A crocheted item.
8. A hand knitted garment.
9. A handmade Christmas card without embellishments. (One entry may be printed and used as the YCA 2023 Christmas card).
10. Any other handicraft not listed in the schedule.

PRODUCE

11. Four Savoury Scones.
12. Three Sausage Rolls.
13. A Lemon Drizzle Loaf.
14. A Victoria sandwich, three egg mixture with raspberry jam filling and dusted with Caster sugar.
15. Three Brownies.
16. A Quiche Lorraine.
17. An Upside Down Cake.
18. Three Biscuits decorated as a pig.

PRESERVES

Unless otherwise stated, all jars to have cellophane covers and rubber bands or twist tops in good condition.

19. A Jar of Raspberry Jam.
20. A Jar of Strawberry Jam.
21. A Jar of Grapefruit Marmalade.
22. A Jar of Lemon Curd, jar with wax disc and cellophane only.
23. A Jar of Chutney. Jar to have a twist top.
24. A Jar of Piccalilli. Jar to have a twist top.

FLOWERS

Measurements apply to height and width

25. An arrangement with one flower stem and plus foliage.
26. An arrangement entitled "Ruby Anniversary", not to exceed 24" x 24", accessories allowed
27. An arrangement from the hedgerow
28. A small container of mixed herbs, at least three varieties. Not to exceed 12" x 12"
29. An arrangement of supermarket flowers costing no more than £8 - not to exceed 24" x 24"
And receipt to be displayed. Foliage may be used.
30. An arrangement of garden flowers in a teacup.
31. A Flower arrangement in a crisp packet.

RECYCLING

32. An item made from a plastic milk bottle.
33. A pig made from recycled materials.
34. A item illustrating recycling.

SPECIAL CLASS

35. An item relating to the Coronation, any medium.

YCA SECTION RULES

- ◇ Only YCA Members may compete
- ◇ All entries must be made by the exhibitor, not shown at any previous Tockwith Show and have been completed within the last 12 months.
- ◇ Items are exhibited at owner's risk
- ◇ All exhibitors in the Flower Classes must provide their own receptacles
- ◇ Labels must be securely fastened to all exhibits where possible.
- ◇ **All vehicles must be removed from the show field by 10.00am**
- ◇ All exhibits must be staged by 10.30am on Sunday 6th August 2023
- ◇ Presentation of Trophies will take place at 3.45pm
- ◇ **No exhibits may be removed before 4pm** after which time the Committee cannot be held responsible for loss or damage
- ◇ Objections must be made to the YCA Secretary before 3.30pm on the day of the Show
- ◇ **The Judge's decision is final**
